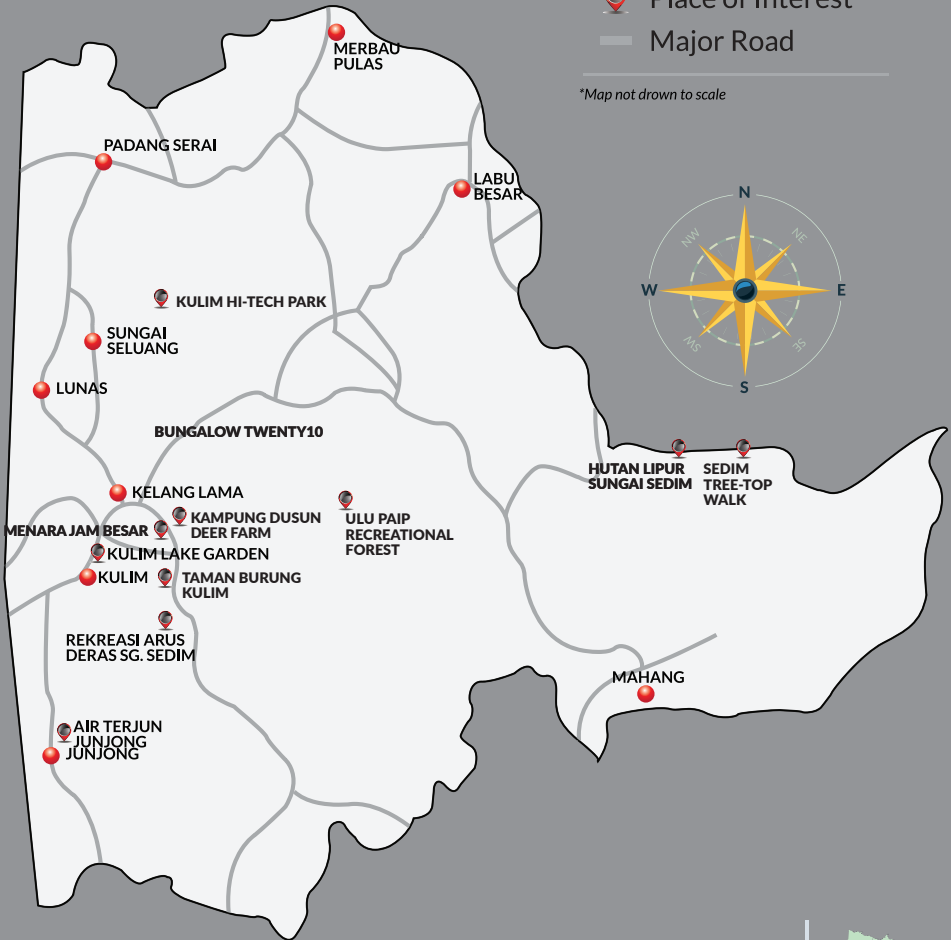
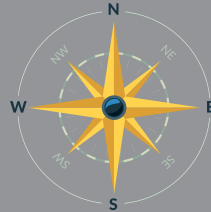

-  Major Road

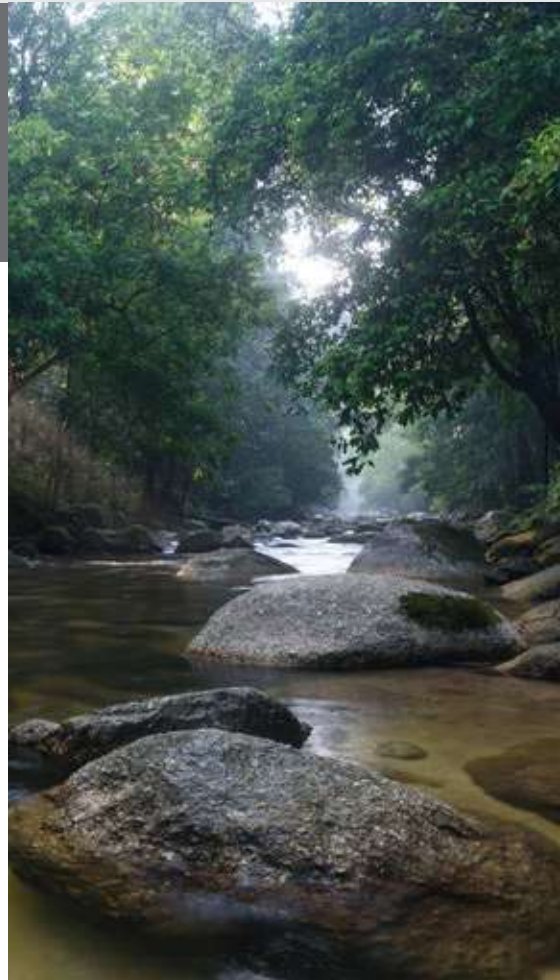

Kulim ATTRACTIONS

SUNGAI SEDIM TREE-TOP WALK

Billed as the world's longest rainforest canopy walk at a length of 925m with a height of about 26m above the forest ground at its highest point, the Sg. Sedim Recreational Park tree-top walkway follows a roughly rectangular route and crosses the fast-flowing river twice. It's a sturdy set of steel bridge structures completed in 2005 and for the most part is not attached to trees, thus causing no damage to flora. It provides a spectacular bird's eye view of the roof of the beautiful rainforest and that usually captures your attention away from any wobbling or height dizziness



SUNGAI SEDIM RIVER RAPIDS RECREATION

For the adventurous - this is for you! A fast-flowing river, Sungai Sedim is considered one of Malaysia's top 5 best whitewater rafting destinations, with a fairly tough range of up to 15km and reaching Grade 4. Kayaking, swimming, picnicking, camping, hiking and such outdoor activities are also available

here. It is popular as well for outdoor nature or team-building courses, workshops and group programmes. Just 30 minutes from Kulim town, the area is at the border between Kulim and neighbouring Baling district, and is now even titled as a Kedah Royal Camping Site



GUNUNG BUNGSU MOUNTAIN FOREST RESERVE

At a height of 658m, this modest mountain provides a medium-tough challenge that still affords great scenic views and hiking route of diverse flora and fauna. There's even a trail for mountain biking and cycling. Traces of history can still be found as the mountain

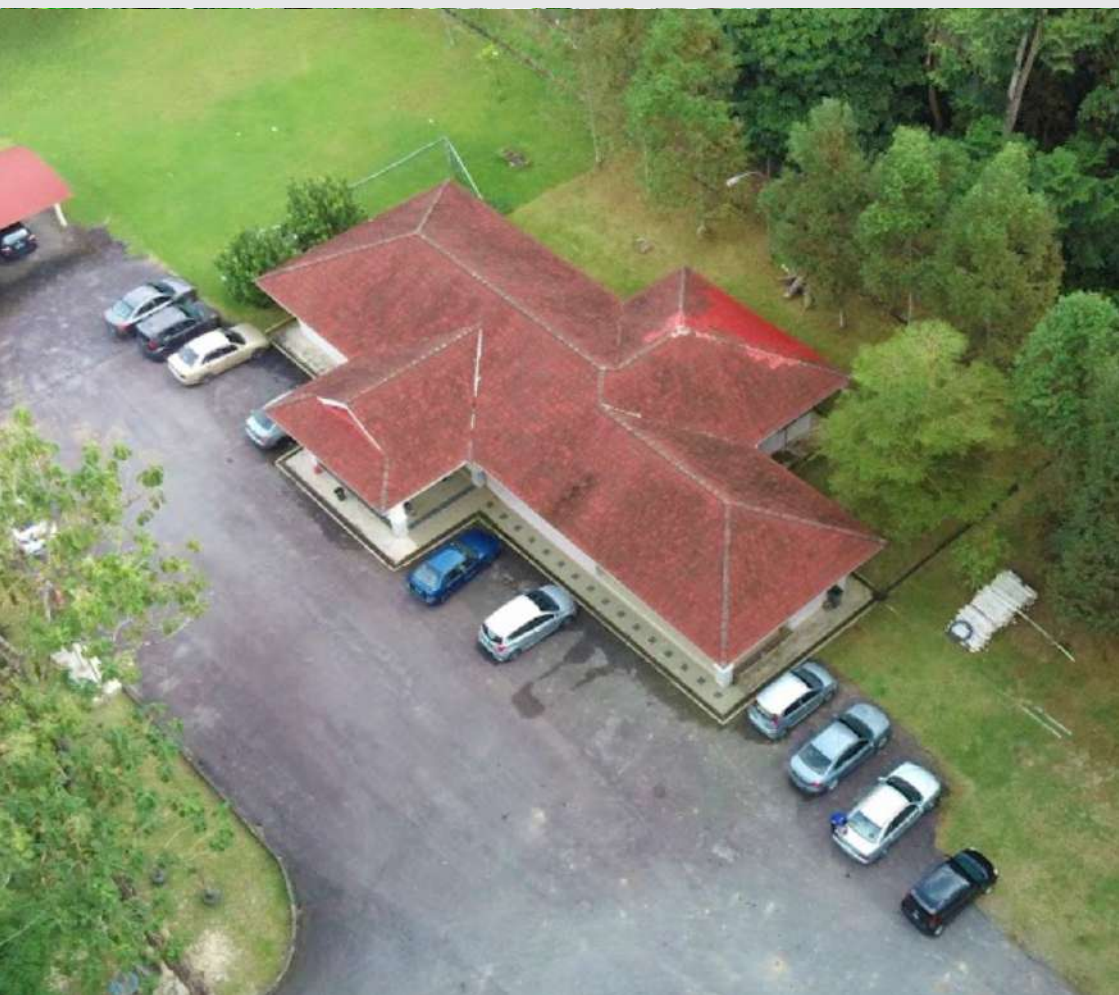
was once used by communist insurgents during the 1950s Emergency period. The winding river with little bubbly rapids are part of the beauty of this tropical jungle paradise.



PAHAU EDUCATIONAL FOREST

Amidst the verdant forest reserve of Gunung Bungsu mountain range just 23km from Kulim town, Pahau is an educational forest that boasts a myriad selection of replanted forest plant species to conserve the surrounding jungle ecosystem. Main

attractions here include educational tours to the research centre and witnessing the forest conservation development, jungle trekking, camping and other outdoor especially nature education activities.





GUNUNG BINTANG MOUNTAIN PEAK

This 1,862m peak is the highest in its immediate mountain range. The trail up to the top will pass by pristine river rapids, waterfalls and diverse flora and fauna. A little detour for some interesting cave spelunking is also possible on the mountain-side. Geographical map-wise, a special thing about Mount Bintang's summit is that it is a natural boundary point between Kulim and Baling districts in Kedah as well as Ulu Perak and Selama districts in neighbouring Perak state. Thus standing at the mountain top puts you in four different administrative entities at once.



Who doesn't love a lake garden? Even though this is a simple waterbody tucked in between Kulim town's transport terminal and Seri Malaysia Hotel, Taman Tasik Kulim's central location is in fact one reason for its popularity. Come by for a stroll after a meal or even while having a snack on-the-go, or better still for a round of jogging as some locals do on the pedestrian trail around the lake.

PADANG SERAI SUNDAY MARKET

The small but fast-growing town of Padang Serai in Kulim district is famous for its 'Pekan Ahad' Sunday market. This is a genuine neighbourhood open-air market for surrounding area residents and thus authentic as opposed to 'touristy'. It offers a whole gamut of goods from fresh produce to household items to even handicraft or 'flea market' type stalls. Come early while it's nice and cool, and products for sale are still plentiful. Take in the bright colours, smell the enticing odours, taste local fruits and foods, and feel the ambiance of a real traditional market.



KULIM HI-TECH PARK

Not only is it the first hi-tech industrial park development in Malaysia established in 1996, it is considered the crème de la crème of greenfield high technology parks in Asia that has proven to provide viability for local and international companies to do research and production in a world-class business environment. A tour will showcase how KHTP has grown from almost nothing into a sustainable economic growth area that raises immense benefits for both investors and Malaysians.



JUNJUNG WATER FALLS



Cool yourself from the hot tropical weather with a visit to Kulim's own Junjung waterfall recreational park. Just a short 14km drive from Kulim town and you find yourself in a rainforest eco-system that also borders green rubber tree plantation and fruit orchards. In fact during the different fruiting seasons especially durians and mangosteens you can buy them directly from local farmers. Of course, you can always come for bathing and swimming in the river waterfall area as well as picnicking and even overnight camping.

ULU PAIP WATERFALL RECREATIONAL FOREST



Just 15km east of Kulim, Ulu Paip Recreational Forest has a little river that runs through the park area with a series of rapids and a small waterfall. While not spectacular, it is a pretty place for a picnic and a cool splash. Other outdoor activities such as even bicycle trekking are popular. For the more adventurous, local waterfall seekers found a few larger waterfalls further up the river but it's a challenge as there is no proper trail yet.
